20/20 COMPETITION
PLAYING REGULATIONS - COUNTY ROUNDS

The Laws of Cricket (including the size of bat, ball and wicket and length of pitch) will apply, with the following exceptions:-

- 1.(a) The length of the innings shall be 20 overs. The Final will be of 20 overs per side. One hour and fifteen minutes allowed to bowl the 20 overs.
- (b) Each side must face 5 overs to constitute a match.
- (c) A new ball will be provided for each innings.

2. No player may bowl more than 4 overs (reduced proportionately for reduced over matches).

3. If a bowler breaks down, the remainder of the over will be bowled by another bowler. Such part of an over will count as a full over when working out each bowler's limit.

4. The side which scores the most runs shall be the winner.

5. If the scores are level, the side which has lost the least wickets shall be the winner.

6. If the scores continue level, the winner shall be the side, in order:-
 - (a) which has the higher score over the first 10 overs of the innings
 - (b) which loses the least number of wickets in the first 10 overs of the innings

7. If the scores are still level a bowl out will take place. Toss of a coin by Captains will be a last option.

- 8.(a) If rain curtails a match, the winner shall be the side scoring most runs in the first 10 overs of the innings, or 9, 8, 7, 6 down to 5.
- (b) Rain affected games. Overs will be deducted at the rate of one per 3.75 minutes to a minimum of 5 overs per side.

Note: The ESCA/ECB regulations concerning CLOSE FIELDERS and Helmets will apply in all matches.

The ECB would like the following: Sight Screen - A White sight screen will be used in the National Final. A red ball will be used. This is confirmed. Coloured clothing will not be provided. White pads will be used.

The National Final will not be re-arranged.

INFORMATION

The National 20/20 Final 2010 will take place at the Arundel C.C., Arundel. Four schools, representing the Midlands, North, South and the West will play in the Semi-Finals and then the National Final.

As the Semi-Finals will be played after each other, then followed by the Final, it will be a long day and teams must be prepared for a late finish, possibly in the order of 7pm.

The South Team will play the West Team in the second Semi-Final and the Midland team will play the North Team in the 1st Semi-Final.

Accommodation

The North and Midlands team will be allowed to book hotel accommodation on the night of 7th September 2010 to ensure their early arrival at Arundel on Wednesday, 8th September.

The South and West teams can travel on the day, as they do not need to arrive before 11am.

Travel Expenses

Travel expense forms will be part of the Organisational Document given to the schools. Claims Forms should be handed to Mr Lake on the day.

Food

Meals will be provided on the day.

Umpires/Scorers

Umpires and Scorers will be provided.

Match Balls

Will be provided.

Dressing Rooms

The Dressing Rooms at Arundel Castle will be in use in the Pavilion.

Rules and Regulations

Those sent to all Counties will be in use and will be in the Organisational Document.

Invitations

Each school will receive five invitations for lunch. Please reply with a Yes or a No.

Parking

You will be directed to the parking areas by the Gateman at Arundel Castle Ground .

Timing

This will be a long day and therefore we need your cooperation to keep the day flowing, with teams being ready to start their matches. Losing Semi-Finalists may leave earlier if they wish, as a Bronze Medal Ceremony will be arranged if required before the Final and at the end of the first semi-final.

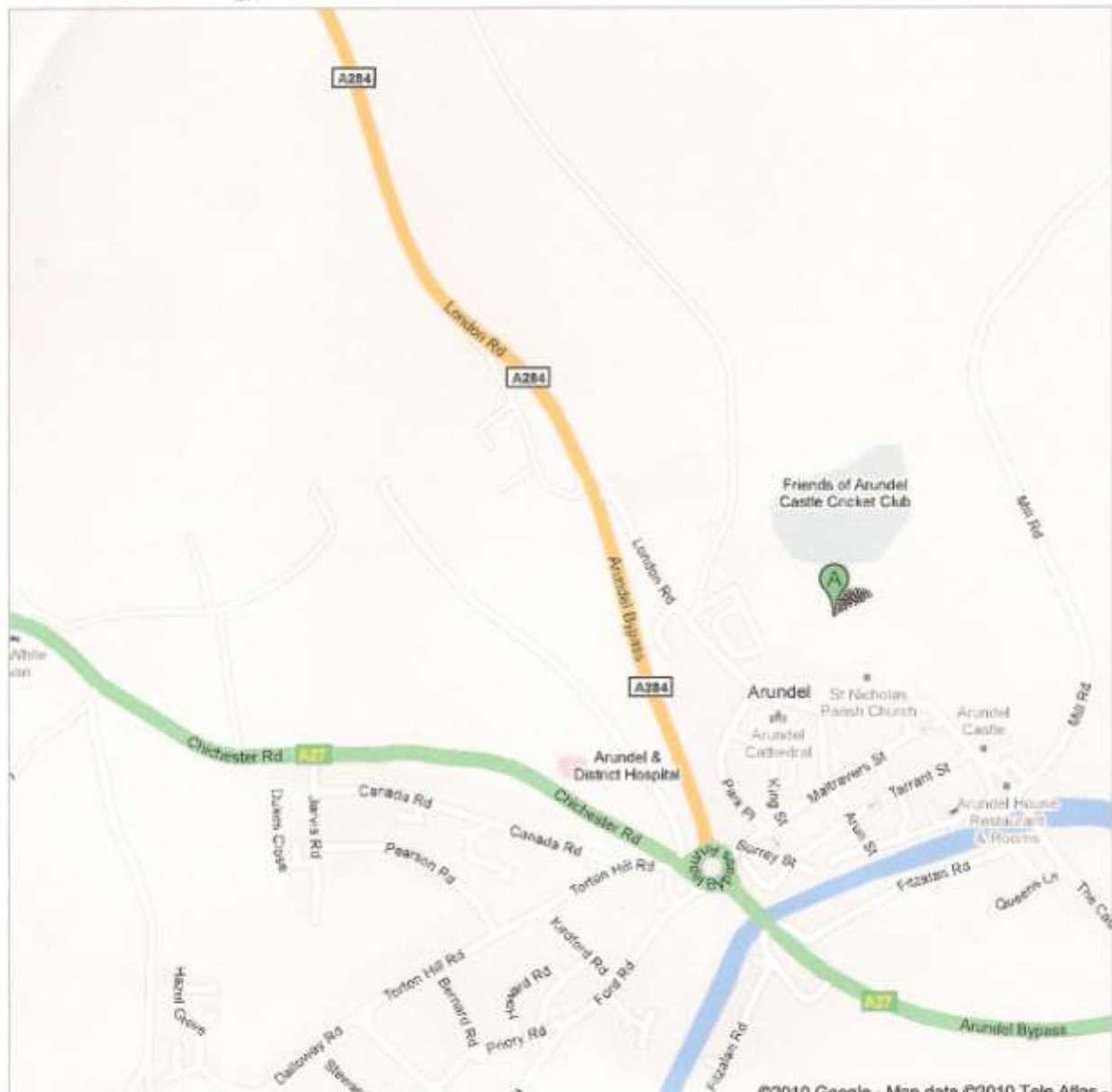

From the A27 Brighton/ Worthing

Approaching the outskirts of ARUNDEL take FIRST EXIT at first roundabout after RAILWAY STATION, following signs to CHICHESTER. At next roundabout take the A284 EXIT, heading NORTH. TURN RIGHT into LONDON ROAD. Take FIRST LEFT to Arundel Castle Cricket Club and follow direction signs.

From the A29 Crawley/ Horsham/ East Grinstead

Follow A29 to large roundabout at the top of BURY HILL. Take SECOND EXIT (A284) to ARUNDEL. Follow signs to COUNTY CRICKET, turning LEFT into LONDON ROAD. Take FIRST LEFT to Arundel Castle Cricket Club and follow direction signs.

From the A27 Chichester

Follow signs to ARUNDEL. Take FIRST EXIT at first roundabout onto A284. TURN RIGHT into LONDON ROAD. Take FIRST LEFT to Arundel Castle Cricket Club and follow direction signs.
